

The Jasper County Commission met in general session at 9:00 a.m. at the Jasper County Courthouse, room 101. The meeting was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance followed with Sheriff Kaiser's prayer.

Roll Call:

John Bartosh, Darieus Adams and Jim Honey are present.

Approval of minutes:

Commissioner Honey made the motion to approve the minutes of July 5, 2016. Commissioner Adams seconded. Minutes approved.

New Business:

The City of Jasper has begun the process of annexing territory surrounding the Interstate 49 corridor from approximately one half mile north of exit 66, Thorn Road south to Sumac Road. After some discussion the commission decided they had no comment. It is ultimately the state's decision.

Public Hearings:

Jerad Norton, Tri-State Engineering, presented the annual storm water management report. It is the third permit term – June, 2015-June, 2016. The report contains the management plan, the completed activity schedule and the proposed activity schedule for 2016-2017.

Sheriff Kaiser informed the commission that lightning hit the antenna at the jail on Thursday, 7, 2016. They are compiling a list of the damage (lights, compressor, printers). The insurance will cover but the county does have a \$5,000.00 deductible.
