

The Jasper County Commission met in general session on Tuesday, July 5, 2016 at the Jasper County Courthouse, room 101. The meeting was opened at 9:00 a.m. with the Pledge of Allegiance and prayer by Sheriff Kaiser.

Roll Call:

John Bartosh and Jim Honey present. Darieus Adams absent.

Approval of minutes:

Commissioner Honey made the motion to approve the minutes of June 28, 2016. Commissioner Bartosh seconded. Minutes approved.

Elected officials/Citizen requests:

Mr. Richard Pim presented a request to vacate part of several roads and alleyways in the community of Scotland. It is a platted subdivision however the roads and alleys that he is requesting vacation of have never been used as such. He has presented the proper paperwork. There was discussion about who the land ownership goes to after the vacation of the roads and alleys. Commissioner Honey made the motion to vacate portions of Orchard Street, Main Street, Wall Street, Race Street, Vine Street, Pine and Cedar alleys as described in the petition. Commissioner Bartosh seconded. Vacation of roads and alleys approved.

New Business:

The commission is requesting funds from the emergency fund to fix a concrete lip on the old drive-thru area at annex II. G & G Construction submitted a bid of \$3,412.00. Commissioner Honey made the motion to approve the bid of \$3,412.00 from G & G Construction and to be paid from the emergency fund. Commissioner Bartosh seconded. Motion approved.

Public Hearings:

Auditor Richard Webster presented a request from the court system to amend the 2016 budget for juvenile housing and transportation. The county has been paying Greene County to house juveniles overnight and has exhausted the budget amount allocated. The county received \$100,000.00 from the state in April and placed it in the county reserve fund. Mr. Webster is proposing to transfer \$50,000.00 to the juvenile detention line item. By state statute the county must wait 10 days before approving this amendment.

With no further business the meeting was adjourned.
